




1. What percentage of your patients who are currently either pregnant, considering pregnancy in the next year, or are parents of a baby up to age one now ask you for information about breastfeeding?




What percentage of your patients want to know the reasons why breastfeeding is a good idea?




3. On a scale of 1 to 10, rate how important your patients believe breastfeeding to be.




4. I currently support the AAP recommendations that infants breastfeed for at least the first year of life.



5. Rate the availability of breastfeeding resources in the community.




6. What is your medical provider specialty?






9. Have you been aware of the display with Breastfeeding information displayed in your office?
